Regional average earnings per job are **\$21.2K below** the national average earnings of \$85.0K per job.


Takeaways

- As of 2024 the region's population increased by 11.6% since 2019, growing by 75,561. Population is expected to increase by 11.3% between 2024 and 2029, adding 81,994.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs increased by 9.1% in CSRC Tri-County from 233,621 to 254,899. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 3.9% by 5.2%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 51.8% to 50.7% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, 19.4% of the selected regions' residents possess a Bachelor's Degree (2.0% below the
 national average), and 10.8% hold an Associate's Degree (1.9% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and General Medical and Surgical Hospitals.









Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends









Millennials
















Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration








Top Industry GRP







Top Occupation Employment Concentration





Educational Pipeline

In 2023, there were 4,466 graduates in CSRC - Tri-County. This pipeline has shrunk by 16% over the last 5 years. The highest share of these graduates come from "Liberal Arts and Sciences/Liberal Studies" (Associate's), "Registered Nursing/Registered Nurse" (Associate's), and "Business Administration and Management, General" (Certificate).
